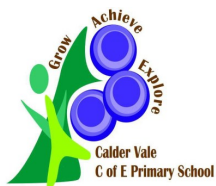

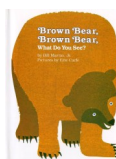


A message from Mrs. Scholz

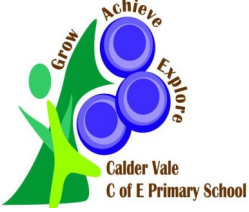
Bluebell Class – Our Lead Learner is Vinnie for brilliant listening and concentration working with Mrs. Pollitt
