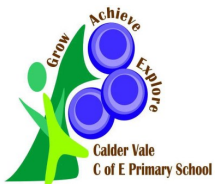

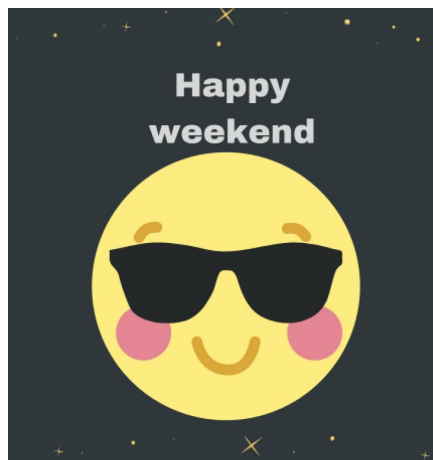
A message from Mrs. Scholz

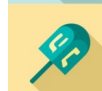
Mrs. Nickson
