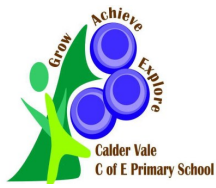

Bluebell Class – George for being an all round Bluebell Superstar and fabulous role model for everyone in school.

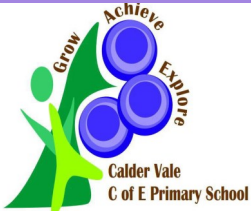
