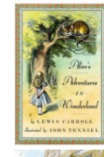
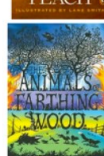
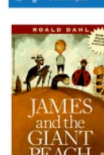
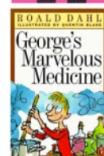


A message from Mrs. Scholz

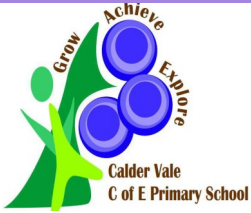
