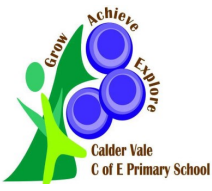

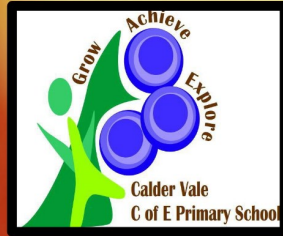
Lead Learners
