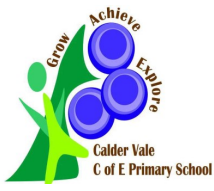

Bluebell Class

In English, EYFS have been enjoying the story of The Gingerbread Man and even made our very own delicious gingerbread men and women. Key Stage One have been authors this week and have written their own versions of The Perfect Pet, their writing has been fantastic and they have been working hard on using their phonics to support spelling unfamiliar words.
