Bluebell Class

EYFS have been on their very own bear hunt, crawling under tables and bravely exploring a dark cave! In maths KS1 have been building on their knowledge of telling the time by counting in 5's. Telling the time is really tricky and something we can practice at home to help us remember. EYFS have been counting objects to 20 and making marks to represent how many there are. We are super at knowing the numbers to 20. EYFS have been busy in topic finding out where bears live and what they look like. We have looked at if the countries they live in are the same or different to where we live. KS1 have been comparing Nairobi to London by identifying the human and physical features of both capital cities. What a busy week!

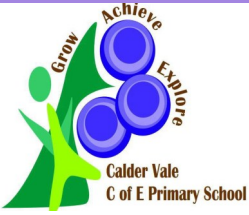
